

# Tour General Terms & Conditions \*Please read carefully – This is your responsibility

### 2020 Tour Package 1: South Africa - Only

The total South Africa tour package price is based on double occupancy \$4,700.00 per person, (price is effective, if the deposit is received by December 31, 2019, otherwise the price will be \$5,300.00 between January 1st and March 30th), for all accommodations, tours and meals per the itinerary and international flights on our selected airline from Los Angeles California. After April 1st the price will be provided based on current airline and tour costs on a case by case basis. Single occupancy pricing is provided below on the payment plan schedule.

**2020 Tour Package 2: South Africa & Zimbabwe,** The total South Africa & Zimbabwe tour package price is based on double occupancy \$5,500.00 per person, (price is effective, if deposit is received by December 31, 2019, otherwise the price will be \$6,100.00 between January 1st and March 30th), for the accommodations and tours per the itinerary and international flights on our selected Airline from Los Angeles California. After April 1st the price will be provided based on current airline and tour costs on a case by case basis. Single occupancy pricing is provided below on the payment plan schedule.

**Departure City Other Than Los Angeles:** If you are leaving from an airport other than the Los Angeles Airport a cost quote will be provided. Contact our office to confirm a package price if your flight departure city is not Los Angeles, California. Any quoted airline prices for nonstandard routing are time bound and subject to change. If we are not able to accommodate your flight arrangements or if you choose to make your own flight arrangements, on your request, we will offer land package accommodations/tours, per the itinerary.

#### **General Terms and Conditions of Tours**

#### Note:

- 1. There is a \$300 late fee charge, if the final payment is received after May 1st.
- 2. Other payment schedules exist depending on the specific tour package with the option for Double or Single Occupancy
- 3. If payments cannot be made by due date contact a Tour Organizer to make arrangements. Failure to make payments or arrangements will lead to cancellation of your reservation.

The payment schedules above are for travelers who purchase our tour package that includes flight accommodations leaving from Los Angeles, CA, U.S.A. If the traveler is on a land only tour or is departing on a flight arranged by the Tour Organizer from other than Los Angeles the payment schedule has the same dates, but with adjusted cost based on confirmed tour package price.

Final Payment: Any remaining balance is due by May 1. Any final payment received after defined due date are subject to a \$300 late fee. No personal or company checks will be accepted within 21 days prior to departure. No travel documents will be issued until tour is paid in full.

Invoice: An invoice will be sent to you via e-mail each time you make a payment. Please verify the details on your invoice. Also keep up with the payments and your own documented payment history for management purpose.

Cancellation Policies: If you need to cancel your tour commitment, we will need a detail confirmation e-mail send to africanfocustrailblazers@gmail.com. We will process your credit & refund options within 2 - 3 business days. If you are eligible for a credit, it can be put towards our next tour. After the next tour the credit will no longer be valid and becomes a full lost. Credits are optional offers from the Tour Organizer and are based on your cancellation situation. Only 50-75% of the money you have paid less any penalty will be offered as a credit. If you are eligible

31-60 days priors to departure	75% Loss of tour cost

Disabled Tour Participants: Any disability requiring special attention should be reported to the tour organizers/sponsors at time of reservation. The tour organizers/sponsors will make reasonable attempts to accommodate special needs of disabled tour participants, but is not responsible for any denial or services by carriers; hotels, restaurants or other independent suppliers of services that may be used in the fulfillment of this tour. Please note African Focus Trailblazers Tour personnel may not physically lift participants or assist them on or off transportation vehicles. A person requiring such assistance must be accompanied by a responsible and qualified companion.

Meals and Beverages: Each person will be responsible for meals and beverages not included as part of this tour program. Beverage and meals are those indicated in the itinerary and tour overview documentation. Each person will be required to show a "paid in full" receipt before departure from the hotels for any meals, beverages and personal services that are not included in the itinerary.

Gratuities: The tour package price does include gratuities. The tour organizer will be responsible for gratuities to drivers and tour guides, along with other service providers in applicable restaurants and hotels.



Immigration Requirements – Visa Fees: A valid passport with at least 6 months remaining from the trip return date is required for entrance into most countries. A visa issued from their respective Embassy may not be required for entrance into both South Africa and Zimbabwe, applicable.

There will be no tour payment refund whatsoever for failure to obtain all proper admission documents for any country included in this tour. Failure to obtain all valid travel documents including U.S. travelling Passport does not create a right to cancellation or refund.

Health Requirements: Consistent with most African countries, proof of Yellow Fever immunization is required if the traveler is entering South African or Zimbabwe from another African country. Bring your immunization card or immunization certificate or waiver certificate with your passport for review at the country's point of entry. Yellow fever vaccination is good for a lifetime. First time yellow fever vaccinations must be completed no later than 10 days before departure. Kaiser Permanente and drug store pharmacies, like Walgreens and CVS can administer the yellow fever vaccination, but you must request in advance.

Malaria prevention involves protecting yourself against mosquito bites and taking antimalarial medicines. Consult with your doctor for advice and to get a prescription for an anti-malarial medicine. Anti-malarial drugs require a doctor's prescription.

Caution: To avoid digestive problems, drink bottled or purified water (without ice); drink plenty of fluids; eat peeled fruits and cooked vegetable/fish/meat. For additional information, do your own research about safe foods to eat or check with a natural heath practitioner for recommendations.

Documentation: We are committed to documenting our story and will use pictures, videos, audio, journalism and other means to promote/market this source of work. Tour documentations will be shared publicly. Any tour member who does not want to be a part of any documentation must let a tour organizer know immediately. We will not be able to change any public project if notification is not given a head of time.
